The first time I encountered a labor and delivery unit in the United States, I was fascinated. I don't believe that anywhere else in the world provides a safer or more comfortable space for expectant mothers. Equipped with the latest and best technologies, nothing is left to chance.

Coming from a different country and being used to a different environment, I felt a strong desire to use my knowledge and technology to reduce the number of preterm births, and to provide future mothers with the security and comfort in delivery rooms in their homeland. American intensive care units (ICUs) are so well-equipped to take care of a 500-gram preterm baby, that after a stay in the ICU, it is to be expected that the baby will achieve a healthy weight, and be released thriving. The conditions in my homeland are not even close to this. For me and other obstetricians, as well as for the expectant mother, the most difficult period is from the loss of a premature baby until the next pregnancy that results in a healthy, full-term delivery. I am dedicating myself to trying to equip and modernize labor and delivery rooms with the latest tests during pregnancy, in order to help future mothers avoid unpleasant and traumatizing situations, and bring more babies to full term.

The foundation functions strictly on a volunteer basis. I will personally visit delivery rooms and teach the staff how to use the equipment, most of which will be purchased and shipped from American companies. With your support, I hope to maximize my efforts in decreasing the number of preterm births. In addition, with the help of my extraordinary colleagues, I will personally monitor the necessity of equipment in all delivery rooms in the region. The stay of a premature baby in the ICU increases the cost of health care. In spite of the care received, if the baby survives, the possibility of vision and hearing loss, asthma, learning and other difficulties still exists.
